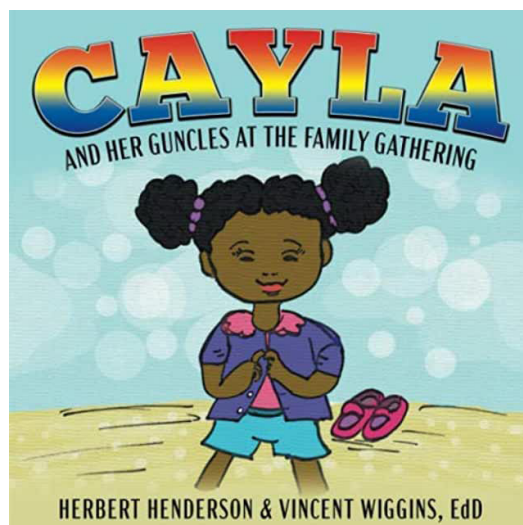
Enjoy Fun Times with Cayla and Her Guncles
